Elaine La Roche is the Chief Executive Officer of China International Capital Corporation U.S. Securities in New York, and has been involved on Wall Street and in China for several decades. She spent over twenty years at Morgan Stanley and has been involved with CICC from its inception in 1995, serving as its CEO in Beijing from 1997-2001.

She currently serves as a Director of Marsh & McLennan Companies and serves on their Audit and Finance Committees. Additionally, she is an Independent Director of the Harsco Corporation, where she sits on the Audit and Nomination Committees. She was an Independent Director of China Construction Bank from 2005-2011 and from 2012-2015, serving on its Audit and Strategy Committees and as Chair of its Nomination and Compensation Committee.

At Morgan Stanley, her twenty-two year career spanned roles in Institutional Sales and Investment Banking in the US and Europe as well as management roles as Head of the Public Finance Department, Head of Global Corporate Services, and Chief of Staff to the Chairman and President.

From 2008 to 2010 she was Vice Chairman of JPMorgan China Securities in Beijing.

She has served as Non- Executive Chairman of Linktone, a NASDAQ listed Chinese wireless company based in Shanghai, and has been a visiting professor in the MBA and Executive MBA programs at Peking University.

Before coming to Wall Street, she held a number of positions in the Office of the U.S. Secretary of the Treasury, the Office of Economic Opportunity, and the White House Office of the Hon. Donald Rumsfeld, Counselor to the President.

A graduate of Georgetown University, School of Foreign Service with a BS in International Affairs, she also holds an MBA in Finance from American University.
